Our experienced trainers are fully certified and multi-disciplinary with post-graduate qualifications in complimentary fields. We do not coerce or try to illicit any disclosures. We will be using observational and auditory survey techniques to complete reports and feedback possible concerning behaviours.

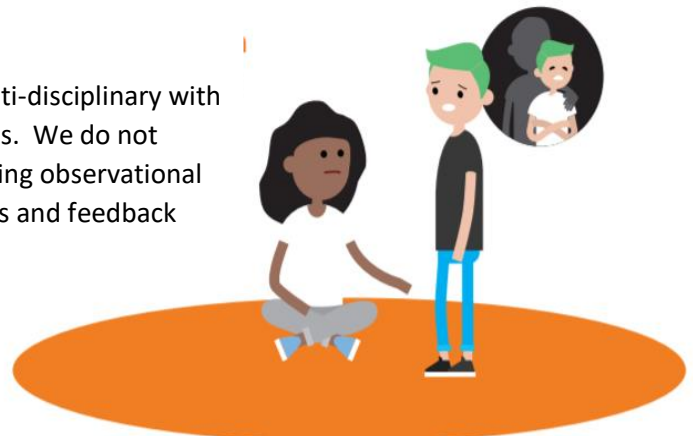

PB West ISPBEP sessions include the following

- An initial session with caregivers/parents to assess areas of need and to support and empower the re-establishment of a safe environment.
- Subsequent sessions with child/children (listed below) include the themes;
We all have the right to feel safe all the time and we can talk with someone about anything. We also include rights and responsibilities in each session
 - Developing rapport & safety networks (including assessment of child's support needed)
 - Feelings, early warning signs, personal space and body ownership
 - Public private, secrets and assertiveness, body ownership
 - Safe and unsafe touch, network review, theme reinforcement, re-establishing body ownership.

A comprehensive report will be forwarded to the referring agency along with any further recommendations upon completion of the program. Concerning behaviours or disclosures will be reported immediately.
